All Tax Exemptions

Property tax in Texas is locally assessed and locally administered - there is no state property tax. Taking advantage of the tax exemptions available can greatly reduce the amount you have to pay each year for taxes.

Tax Exemption Types Include: Homestead, Age 65 or Older or Disabled, Manufactured and Cooperative Housing, Uninhabitable or Unstable Residence, Temporary Exemption for Disaster Damage.

How to File?

It's FREE to file! You can obtain an application for an exemption from the County Central Appraisal District in which your primary residence is located.

To qualify: You must include a copy of the applicant's Texas driver license or Texas identification certificate with the application. The address on the license or certificate must correspond to the address of the property for which an exemption is claimed on the application.
